Admission Requirements

To qualify for military medic advanced standing, individuals must have met the following criteria:

- Meet minimum Military/Reservist medical experience requirements with additional civilian health care experience as needed
- Minimum GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale
- Completion of all required prerequisite general education courses with a "C" (2.0) or above
- Applicants with a non-nursing baccalaureate degree are exempt from the 7-year time expiration requirement and are only required to complete the following six prerequisites: Anatomy & Physiology I, Anatomy & Physiology II, Microbiology, Nutrition, Human Growth and Development, and Statistics.

Benefits of Advanced Standing for Military Medic

- Open to service members who trained and served in select military classifications and who were discharged in the last two years or within five years for those who have been employed in a civilian health care role: Army medics, Navy hospital corpsmen, Air Force flight medics, and other military medical specialists regardless of branch of service.
- Qualified students will receive nine credits of advanced standing for military training.
- Assistance navigating student related GI Bill, VA, and other service benefits.
