ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- A baccalaureate or higher degree in a non-nursing discipline OR two years of healthcare experience
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Completion of all required prerequisite general education courses with a "C" (2.0) or above
 - o Anatomy and Physiology I with lab-4 credits
 - o Anatomy and Physiology II with lab-4 credits
 - Human Growth and Development-3 credits
 - Medical Terminology-2 or 3 credits
 - Microbiology with lab-4 credits
 - Nutrition-3 credits
 - Statistics-3 credits

- Applicants who do not hold a bachelor's degree must also have completed the following courses prior to the first semester of the program:
 - Anthropology-3 credits
 - College Algebra-3 credits
 - English Composition I-3 credits
 - English Composition II-3 credits

A minimum of 35 credits in the BSN major must be completed at Trinity College to meet graduation requirements.

The BSN curriculum is aligned to *The Essentials: Core Competencies for Professional Nursing Education* (American Association of Colleges of Nursing, 2021). <u>Contact hours</u> are learning experiences planned by faculty; additional study time beyond the contact hours is expected. The allocation of contact hours between synchronous and asynchronous learning is approximate and may be adjusted.

TRANSFERABLE COURSES

Trinity College maintains cooperative agreements with Black Hawk College, Eastern Iowa Community Colleges, and Portage Learning. These institutions offer all general education courses required for the BSN degree. Academic credit will generally be accepted from other regionally accredited institutions upon review. Admission representatives will unofficially review transfer credit for applicants during the pre-application process. Upon receipt of the application, the Registrar will evaluate the student transcript to formally approve transfer credit.
