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ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

BSN completion students are awarded up to 70 credit hours upon acceptance into the program in recognition of previous education coursework required for registered professional nursing licensure.

- Proof of unrestricted RN license from a state board of nursing
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale

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TRANSFERABLE COURSES
